## **DFW Airport Interfaith Chaplaincy to Celebrate National Day of Prayer, Thursday, May 5**

(DFW AIRPORT, TX – April 27, 2011) – On April 17, 1952, after being unanimously approved by both houses of congress, President Harry Truman signed into law a National Day of Prayer for the United States. From 1952 to 1988, the then current president would select a day within the year for national prayer. In 1988, President Ronald Reagan amended the law, with broad bipartisan sponsorship and support, designating the first Thursday of May as the official National Day of Prayer.

The National Day of Prayer invites people of all faiths within the United States to pray for our nation and its leaders.

This year, the DFW Airport Interfaith Chaplaincy will offer multiple 15-20 minute prayer services throughout the day for those within the DFW International Airport community interested in participating in the National Day of Prayer:
